



Math Makes Measuring Easier

Measuring accurately is probably the most important skill in the kitchen. No matter how much you have cooked, it always pays to carefully measure the ingredients called for in a recipe.

How's your math? Let's find out.

A math fact to remember is that there are 16 tablespoons in a measuring cup. How many tablespoons in $1/2$ cup? (There are 8 tablespoons.) How many in $1/4$ cup? (There are 4 tablespoons.)

Another good math fact to remember is that there are 3 teaspoons in a tablespoon. What 2 measuring spoons could you use if a recipe calls for 4 teaspoons? (You could use 1 tablespoon and 1 teaspoon.)

Recipes are made for accurate—level, not heaping—measurements. Remember your math!
